Along with Gary Davis and Sylvia Rimm, he is an author of the popular textbook, *Education of the Gifted and Talented* (6th ed.). He is the Director of the National Center for Research on Gifted Education (NCRGE), which replaces the former National Research Center on the Gifted and Talented (NRC/GT).

She is the recipient of the 2015 NAGC Doctoral Student Award, 2016 NAGC Doctoral Dissertation Award, and is a former educator of the year.
